
Although I'm no longer a company member, Dacha will forever have a piece of my little artist heart. So, consider yourselves invited to Dacha's 2025 gala!!

Of all the things I could share in this moment – there are so many – maybe it would be nice just to sit for a second and take in this gorgeous gorgeous scenery of Hells Canyon and Snake River I took during an extremely painstaking hike this past May 24th. I'd highly recommend listening, also, to this soundtrack I found a few weeks ago that never fails to bring me into vismaad.

Did you do it? I'm not here to tell you what to do boo boo, so if you don't want to do it, don't do it. (WHO is this lady I am quoting from IG, PLEASE someone enlighten me.)

Anyway, hopefully now we're on the same-ish, chill frequency 😊

One thing about me is that I love a quote, and will often choose one to live by for a chunk of time. I absorb as much wisdom as I can, then I move on, until I am ready to return again, re-learning, or hopefully, deepening.

Recently, it has been this quote my therapist shared with me a month ago:

"Discipline is when your identity becomes so strong that you stop negotiating with your feelings." OOF. Right?? Oof.

I mean have a god-awful relationship with the word discipline, but hear me out.

I struggle SO much with resistance in the form of old habits, <u>the 5 hindrances</u>, fear of change, numbness, etc. – the list is long.

But all of that can suddenly seem so small in the face of who I am / who I want to be. Isn't that incredible??

It's been a life-changing tool, being able to pause in a moment of resistance, to ask:

"Am I negotiating with my feelings right now?"

"Do I want to be negotiating?"

"What does Adele really, truly, want and need in this moment?"

Often, the answer is clear. Frustrating, sure, but clear.

And THEN, my therapist hit me again this week with:

"Responsibility is the ability to respond (response + ability), in a way that is aligned for you." So... practicing discipline... allows you to take responsibility... which then opens the gateway to reclaiming agency.

ASHFJKSLALDHIEPAJSK?!??!!!?

I hope that blew your mind as much as it did mine, and if you already knew all of this, we need to talk. It's really not just a bunch of intellectual quotes to me.

It is deeply a way of life, impacting everything I say, everything I do, every choice I make.

I wanted to include this last reflection section in this email because this outreach means so much more to me than just a transactional ask for your support. Am I crazy for hoping that people will read all the way to the end of this email? In this economy?? Maybe. But that's outside my control, and this way of connecting with you is just what feels right for me right now, with limited time / energy / opportunity to hangout with y'all in person -- I hope to receive whatever form of connection that feels right for you too!
